The Dhreaded Dheadline Dhoom

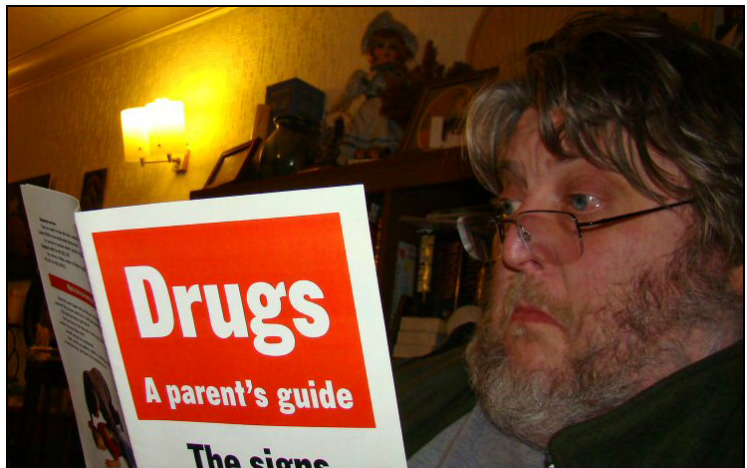
